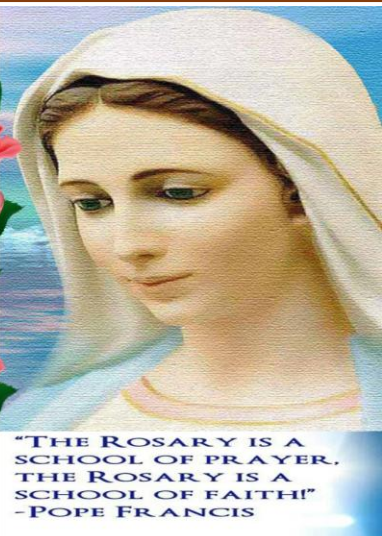

Learning around our parish

Learning has always been an important part of our parish since our pioneer priests championed education for young children. Today, our parish has five learning routes for school-going age groups: Assumption Pathway School, Boys Town, Assumption English School, CHIJ Our Lady Queen of Peace and the Little Shepherds’ Schoolhouse.

Assumption Pathway School started in 1938 as St Joseph’s Trade School, with Bro Robert and Bro Galmier training orphan boys in carpentry, motor mechanics and printing skills. With lack of government support, parish priest Fr Stephen Lee sought funding from Tiger Balm’s philanthropist brothers, Aw Boon Par and Aw Boon Haw. The Aw brothers donated \$6000 to construct a dormitory, workshop and a parochial house.

St Joseph’s Trade School subsequently went through several name changes to align with evolving educational needs: Boys’ Town Trade School in 1970; Boys’ Town Vocational Institute in 1971; Assumption Vocational Institute in 1994 (to enable girls to enrol in 1995); and Assumption Pathway School (APS) in 2009. APS now caters to students unable to complete secondary education, with expanded curriculum in Foundation Studies, Character Education, Vocation Education and Progression to Assumption Pathway Academy, Institute of Technical Education, training institutions like SHATEC (hospitality and tourism school) and employment with APS partners or other companies.

Boys’ Town was conceived in Changi Prison during the Japanese Occupation. Bro Vincent and a fellow internee, Australian businessman-philanthropist William McDermott, discussed the idea of a community of hope for young people modelled after Boys Town in Nebraska, USA. Boys Town in Bukit Timah began in 1948 with 100 boys and 30 boarders affected by the war. Today, Boys Town helps children and youths facing abandonment, abuse and financial problems to be responsible people. It offers Residential Services (education, interest groups, learning workshops and service to community), Youth Reach, Clinical Intervention, Fostering Services (for boys and girls under 18 years), Adventure Centre and Sanctuary Care.

Assumption English School started in 1953 as Boys Town English School for students struggling with standards of mainstream government schools. In later years, the school became a mainstream school when the educational calibre of students improved. In 1973, the school became a co-ed school when its secondary section merged with the secondary section of CHIJ Bukit Timah. The school was then renamed Assumption English School in honour of Our Lady, Mother Mary, Patroness of the Brothers of St Gabriel. The primary section ceased in 1992. Assumption English School was rebuilt in 1993 and 2013-2015, with the new building opened in 2017.

For the girls, CHIJ Bukit Timah started in 1955 at the St Joseph’s Sino-English School with 62 students and then moved to its Chestnut Drive location in 1957. A secondary section started in 1961 but was discontinued in 1973 because of lack of facilities. In 2007, the primary school had a new campus and was renamed CHIJ Our Lady Queen of Peace.

While CHIJ has been successful in Chestnut Drive, the St Joseph’s Sino-English School, which started in the 1930s for poor rural Chinese students, closed in 1980 due to poor enrolments. St Joseph’s Church Kindergarten took over the premises of the Sino-English School in 1985, expanded to include a childcare segment in 2005, and was handed over to Catholic Pre-School Education Singapore (CPES) in 2020. CPES, started in 2019 to consolidate management of parish preschools, ensures common Catholic curriculum, professional staff and modern facilities covering Pre-Nursery, Nursery, Kindergarten 1 and Kindergarten 2 programmes. The Little Shepherds’ Schoolhouse@St Joseph’s Church is one of seven preschools under CPES.

Learning around our parish imbues students with Christ-grounded life values and, hopefully, spurs some of them in the future to study at the Catholic Theological Institute of Singapore (CTIS) or the St Francis Xavier Major Seminary (SFXMS).
